Hiawatha Horse Park is committed to supporting the growth and prosperity of its communities by responsibly giving back and making a positive difference through its involvement in important local initiatives, including:

- **St Joseph's Hospice Charity Drive** – Raise \$765 through charity drive with HUB increasing total donation to \$1,000
