Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

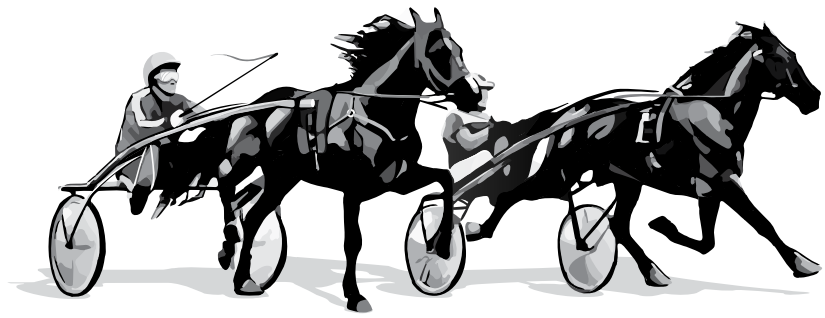
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)

- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

* Numbers listed above are approximate, may vary by racetrack.

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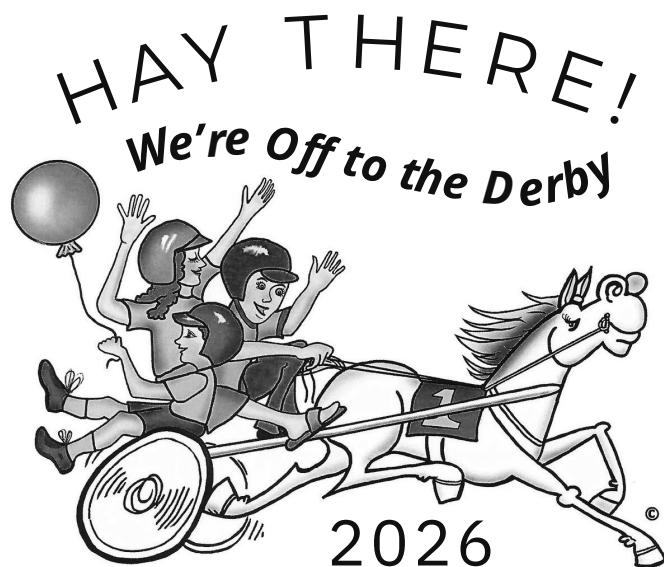

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Harness Racing GLOSSARY OF TERMS

BOXED IN: A horse that is racing on the rail and is surrounded by other horses in front, outside and behind it. A horse that is boxed in is held up and unable to gain a clear passage.

BREAK: To start galloping and lose the natural trotting or pacing rhythm. This occurs more often with trotters than pacers.

CARD: Another term for a program of racing. For example, a person may refer to there being twelve races on the card, which simply means twelve races will be staged on that particular day.

CATCH DRIVER: A driver which does not train his or her own horses and is engaged by other trainers to drive their horses.

CLAIMING RACE: A race where any of the entrants may be claimed (purchased) for a specified amount.

COLORS: The colorful suit (also called "silks") worn by drivers/trainers. Unlike Thoroughbred racing, the drivers/trainers register their own colors and wear them every time they race.

COLT: A male 3 years of age or less.

CONDITIONED RACE: A race where eligibility is based on age, sex, money won, or races won. For example, "3-year-old colts who are non-winners of \$10,000 lifetime or 4 races."

COVER: A horse that races with another horse in front of him is said to race with cover, as the leading horse cuts the wind resistance.

DEAD HEAT: A situation in which the judges cannot separate two or more horses when judging the outcome of a race. This race is declared a tie (Dead Heat).

DISTANCED: A horse that is out of touch with the rest of the field at the end of the race. This is often referred to as "finished distanced".

FIRST-OVER: The first horse to make a move on the leader in a race, moving up on the outside.

FREE LEGGED: A pacer which races without wearing hobbles.

HOME STRETCH: The straight length of the track, nearest the spectators, heading toward the finish line. It is called this because it is the final part of the track a horse travels down on its way 'home' (or the finish line).

HOPPLES: The straps which connect the front and rear legs on the same side of a horse. Most pacers wear hobbles to help balance their stride and maintain a pacing gait. The length of hobbles is adjustable and a trainer registers the length that best suits his or her horse. There are also trotting hobbles that work through a pulley system to help trotters maintain their gait.

INQUIRY: Judging officials may conduct an inquiry as a result of any incident which may have occurred during a race, to determine whether or not certain drivers and/or horses were responsible for the incident.

PACER: Are horses whose legs move in a lateral motion, meaning the two legs on the same side of the body move in unison. For example, both right legs move forward as both left legs are going back.

PARKED: A horse racing on the outside, with at least one horse between it and the inside rail.

PHOTO FINISH: When two horses cross the finish line too closely to identify a winner, officials call for a photograph of the race, taken exactly at the finish line, to help them determine which nose is ahead.

POCKET: A horse in a pocket is unable to obtain a clear path because it has other horses situated in front, behind and to the side of it.

POST TIME: Start of the race.

QUALIFIER: A race in which a horse must contest a mile below an established time standard to prove itself capable of competing in pari-mutuel races.

STANDARD BRED: The breed of horse which competes in harness races.

SULKY: Also known as the cart or racebike, the sulky is attached to the harness and carries the driver.

TOTE BOARD: An electronic board, usually in the infield of a track, which posts the odds, amount of money bet, results of a race and the wagering pay-offs.

TROTTER: Horses whose legs on the opposite side of the body move at the same time. For example, the right front and left rear move forward as the left front and right rear move back.

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Children

Children are welcome at Hiawatha Horse Park, but must be under adult supervision at ALL times

General Operations

Pari-mutuel wagering and drug control services are provided under the supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency, a division of Agriculture Canada, the Honourable Lawrence MacAulay, Minister. All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the Pari-Mutuel Betting Regulations issued by the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted. No minor under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket. A claim that a wrong ticket has been issued must be made before the customer leaves the teller's window. A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel Office of the Association within twenty-four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

Cancellation Policy

In the event that cancellation of races should result for any reason after four races have been run in any day's program, no refunds or issuance of rain checks will be made. If a cancellation results before the completion of four races, rain checks will be issued for admission and upon producing the day's Official Program at the program seller's booth, a next day's racing program will be exchanged. Under no circumstances will money be refunded.

Refunds

Subject to the provisions of the Federal Regulations, all monies bet in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is canceled, declared off, declared no contest or postponed beyond the racing card for which it was scheduled. Subject to the Regulations, all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. Where a horse that is part of an entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on that entry remain valid, and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded except when such entry involves the Exactor feature in which case only those tickets coupling the two horses of the same entry shall be refunded.

Fair Start

The starter shall have control of the horses from the formation of the post parade until a start has been determined. For purpose of this rule, the determination of the start is when the horses have passed the starting point and have been released by the starter. 22.03 (h) There shall be no recall after the horses have been released by the starter. 22.03 (i) The starter shall endeavour to get all horses away in position and on gait. The starter shall only sound a recall for the following reasons: (i) A horse scores ahead of the starting gate; (ii) There is interference before the horses have reached the starting point; (iii) A horse has broken equipment, which the starter notices; (iv) A horse falls before the starting point; (v) A horse coming to the starting gate in the wrong position; (vi) A malfunction of the starting gate or in the interests of safety. 22.03 (l) If a horse has not reached the Fair Start Pole when the horses are released at the starting point by the starter, the judges shall cause the "inquiry" sign to be displayed immediately.

Breaking Rule

When a horse breaks from its gait in a race the driver shall: (a) take the horse to the outside of other horses where clearance exists and; (b) properly attempt to pull the horse to its gait; (c) lose ground while on the break. If there has been no violation of (a), (b) or (c) above, the horse shall not be set back unless a contending horse on its gait is lapped on the hind quarter of the breaking horse at the finish, however, notwithstanding the foregoing, if interference caused by another driver(s) or horse(s) has caused the horse to be on a break at the finish, the judges may, in their discretion determine not to set the horse back even if a contending horse on its gait is lapped on the hind quarter of the breaking horse at the finish. The judges may set any horse back one or more places if, in their judgment, any of the above violations have been committed, or if the horse goes on an extended break, and the driver may be penalized.

Entry or Field in an Exactor

Exactor pools on races that have an entry (1 and 1A and/or 2 and 2B) or mutuel field (14f, 15f...) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest (ie. 1-1, 2-2, field-field). If the same betting interest finishes first and second, the exactor payout will be on those horses finishing first and third.

Daily Double & Late Double Betting

Where the daily double feature is operated, the daily double is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the winners of each of the two races specified for the daily double and that if the purchaser of a daily double ticket fails to pick the winner of the first half of the daily double his bet is void and that all tickets in the second half of the daily double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the daily double are void no matter what circumstances might affect the programmed running of the second half of the daily double. The daily double is operated as an entirely separate pool and is not affected by wagering in other pools operated on the daily double races. Should a horse or horses (not coupled with a starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the daily double after the first race of the daily double has been declared official, holders of all daily double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the daily double race, shall participate in the Consolation Double pool.

Exactor Betting

Where the exactor feature is operated, the exactor is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two horses to finish, in the exact order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Triactor Betting

A Triactor bet is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first three horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Superfecta Betting

A Superfecta bet is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first four horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Pick-3 or Pick-4 Betting

The Pick-3 and Pick-4 features are betting transactions in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the winners of three or four consecutive races on which the Pick-3 or Pick-4 is scheduled to be run. The winning combination of horses constituting a winning ticket shall be those horses that finish first, in the official order of finish in each leg or feature. Where no tickets have been sold coupling horses finishing first in the official order of finish of each leg of the pool, winning tickets shall be determined in the following sequence: Pick-3: (a) the winner of two legs; (b) one winner of one leg; (c) the three horses finishing second; (d) sequentially thereafter. Pick-4: (a) the winner of three legs; (b) the winner of two legs; (c) one winner of one leg; (d) the four horses finishing second; (e) sequentially thereafter. Pick-3 or Pick-4 Scratches: Rule 11 (1). In the event a Pick-3 or Pick-4 feature ticket designates as a selection in any one or more of the races comprising the Pick-3 or Pick-4, a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in the race, the favorite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch(s) occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection for all purposes. (2) In the event that the money bet in the win pool for (2) two or more favorites is identical, the selection identified in the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

Pari-Mutuel Deductions

In Win, Place, Show, Exactor, Pick 3 and Pick-4 pools 21.3%, Pick-5 pools 11.7%, Daily/Late Double pools 21.9% is retained by the Association, 2.0% Provincial Levy, 0.5% by the Ontario Government and 0.8% by the Federal Government. In Triactor pools 21.3% is retained by the Association, 4.0% Provincial Levy, 0.5% by the Ontario Government and 0.8% by the Federal Government.

Allowances

2-year-old fillies 100%; 2 year-old colts & geldings 75%; 3-year-old fillies 75%; 3-year-old colts & geldings 50%; 4-year-old mares 50%; 4-year-old horses & geldings 25%; 5-year-old mares 25%; Spayed mares and mares 6 years or older receive no allowance. In the case of a claimed horse, said horse need not necessarily increase its claiming price to be eligible to future claiming events.

Rule 7.15

No association shall allow a person under 18 years of age to purchase or cash a ticket. For the purposes of this rule, a "ticket" is defined as a receipt or voucher that is issued by an association for one or more bets on a race or races. The association shall ensure that signs are clearly posted in all areas, or in application forms, where tickets are purchased or cashed, advising the public of the age restriction.

Ticket Cancellation Policy

To protect the interest of patrons, Hiawatha Horse Park has adopted a new Ticket Cancellation Policy, which requires proof of identification when cancelling tickets that exceed \$300.
