- **Bethel Church Family Fun Day:** Provides parking lot for people attending Family Fun Day at Bethel Church.
- **Youth Recreation Facility Access:** Volleyball courts made available for Volleyball Kid's Camp.
- **Sarnia Fitness Challenge:** Grounds used to host the Sarnia Fitness Challenge.
- **Bible Class field trip:** Driving Range used for a local Bible class field trip.
